<b>Crape Myrtle</b>	varies	varies	Sun	D	Summer	varies	L-M	Often too big for selected spaces, needs good air circulation, choose powdery mildew resistant, (Indian Names are the most resistant. Aphids can be a problem, occasionally reseeds.
<b>Mountain Laurel</b>	12-20'	8-12'	S/Pt. Sun	E	Spring	Purple Flwrs	VL	Slow growing evergreen native, purple flowers, native to rocky, limestone soil, needs good drainage.

<b>Bottlebrush</b>	8'	6'	Sun	E	Spring/ Summer	Red flwrs	L	Tropical looking flwrs, needs well drained soil, drought tolerant; pest & disease resistant
<b>Flame Acanthus</b>	3-5'	3-4'	Sun\Pt. Sun	D	Summer to fall	Orange- red flwrs	VL	Med.sized native shrub can be used as low hedge; orange tubular flwrs attract hummingbirds & butterflies, re-seeds aggressively. If frost browns leaves, cut back by 1/3 to 1/2 before spring growth begins.
<b>Black Dalea</b>	1-3'	3'	Sun	D	Summer	Purple flwrs	VL	Native to dry, limestone soils; requires little water, excellent nectar source, shear back after first frost browns leaves
<b>Dwarf Buford Holly</b>	4-6'	3-4'	Sun/Pt. Sun	E	Spring/ Winter	White blooms; red berries	L	Use as evergreen hedge or screen, adapts to many soil types
<b>Dwarf Yaupon Holly</b>	2-4'	2-4'	Sun/Pt. Shade	E	Yr.round	Evergrn foliage	L	Low mounding evergreen shrub; maintains a formal shape, good substitute for Boxwood

<b>Grandmas Yellow</b>	4-5'	3'	Sun	SE	Sprg-Frst	Yellow Flwrs	M	The official "Yellow Rose for Texas" repeat bloomer, most disease resistant yellow rose, fragrant flwrs, very thorny.

<b>Bird of Paradise</b>	5-6' +	3-6'	Sun	D	Summer to Fall	Red/ orange	L	Dependable summer bloomer, tropical looking flwrs, heat tolerant.
<b>Cast Iron Plant</b>	3'	2-3'	Shade	E			L	Good understory plant for dry shade, large green leaves
<b>Calylophus</b>	1-2'	1-2'	Sun/part shade	E	Spring to summer	Yellow Flowers	VL	Good rock garden plant, needs good drainage. Ompact Gold is a low growing variety, good groundcover
<b>Columbine</b>	1-2"	1-2'	Sun/Part Shade	SE	Spring	Yellow flowers	L-M	Prefers moist, well drained soil, reseeds, dormant in summer without water, attracts hummingbirds. You can find different color varieties; yellow & burgandy. They will cross breed and you get different colors.
<b>Blackfoot Daisy</b>	6-12"	1-1.5'	Sun	E	Spring & summer	White with yellow cntrs	VL	Short daisy like blooms all spring & summer, requires dry conditions
<b>Esperanza/ Yellow Bells</b>	4-8'	4-6'	Sun	D	Summer to Fall	Yellow or orange	L-M	Showy blooms, top will die back after freeze, remove spent blooms as needed cut back to 6-8" after cold damage before new spring growth.
<b>Fall Aster</b>	2-3'	2.5-3'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Fall	Purple/ lavender flwrs	L	Native perennial, profuse fall bloomer, lightly prune through spring & summer to keep compact
<b>Gaura</b>	2-3'	3'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Spring to Summer	White/ pink or white	L	Tall flower spikes eith 1" flowers that resemble fluttering butterflies, cut back to 3" after first frost
<b>Bicolor or Butterfly Iris</b>	4'	2-3'	Sun/Part Shade	E	Spring to early summer	Creamy yellow w/ marking	L	

<b>Lambs Ear</b>	1'	1.5'	Sun	D	Yr.round	Gray fuzzy leaves	L	Tolerates dry soil, avoid over watering

<b>Lantana, Texas</b>	3-5'	4-5'	Sun	D	Summer-fall	Orange & yellow flowers	L	Flowers begin yellow & turn orange, attracts butterflies, cut back in winter as desired to keep in bounds
<b>Plumbago</b>	3-4'	4-6'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Summer	Sky blue or white	L-M	Light green foliage, does best w/ morning sun & afternoon shade, cut back to 6" if hard freeze damages
<b>Ruellia, Dwarf</b>	8"-1'	1'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Spring to summer	Blue/ purple to pink	L	Petunia like flower, dwarf varieties include "Katie" or "Bonita". There are taller varieties that are extremely invasive, there is also a ground cover variety to use as a ground cover, needs to be in a confined area.
<b>Shrimp Plant</b>	3-4'	3-4'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Spring to fall	Copper, red	L	Does bes in morning sun, afternoon shade, good for hummingbirds. Cut back in winter to 6" to encourage bushiness
<b>Pink Skullcap</b>	1'	3'	Sun/Part Shade	E	Summer	Pink Flwrs	L	Low growing, very tidy; mounding plant, cut back by 1/3 after bloom to keep compact.
<b>Society Garlic</b>	1.5-2.5'	1.5'	Sun/Part Shade	E	Spring to summer	Pink/ lavender flowers	L-M	Needs well drained soil, solid or variegated leaf forms available
<b>Ornamental Grasses</b>								
<b>Big Muhly</b>	3-4'	3-4'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Fall	White flwrs on 6' stalk	L-M	Clumping blue-green, alternative to Pampasgrass; featherlike blooms in fall, rake or cut back in winter
<b>Deer Muhly</b>	1-1.5'	1-1.5'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Fall	Feathery seed heads	L	Tidy clump grass that maintains a round shape
<b>Gulf Muhly</b>	2-1/2'	2'	Sun/Part Shade	D	Fall	Pink seed heads	L-M	Wispy seed heads for fall color, cut back in winter

<b>Carolina Jessamine</b>		6-20'	Sun/Part Shade	E	Early Spring	Yellow flwrs	M	Twining vine, fragrant, attracts hummingbirds
<b>Crossvine</b>		6-30' +	Sun/Part Shade	SE	Summer	Orange flwrs	L	Tendrils vine attaches to wall; very aggressive

<b>Star Jasmine</b>	20'	12-16'	Sun/Part Shade	E	Spring to Summer	White flowers	L	Fragrant blooms, glossy leaves
<b>Lady Banksia Rose</b>		20' +	Sun/Part Shade	E	Spring	White to Yellow	M	Fast growing climbing rose, needs support & plenty of space. Disease free
